

# Dress Code for 2009-2010

## Ruskin High School

### Monday – Friday

**Shirts:** Students may wear either polo or button-down shirts any day of the week.

- Oxford button-down shirts: boys/girls  
Long sleeve or short sleeve  
Logos are optional. *However, only official school logos allowed*  
Females are allowed to wear no-tuck shirts
- Colors: White  
• Collar
- Polo shirts: boys/girls  
Long sleeve or short sleeve  
Logos are optional. *However, only official school logos allowed*  
Females are allowed to wear banded polo shirts  
No exposed midriiffs allowed
- Colors: White or Royal Blue
- Undershirt/Garment  
• Color: Must match outer shirt

**Pants:** Students may wear slacks or skirts

- Slacks and skirts  
'Dockers' type  
Skirts must be proper length – no more than 2" above the knee  
*If leggings are worn with skirts, the legging must be the same color as the skirts*
- Color: Tan or Navy  
Pants must have belt loops

**Sweaters or Sweatshirts:** May be worn over school button down shirts or polo shirts only

- Sweaters or sweatshirts  
may only be plain or have school logo  
sweatshirts may not have hoods
- Color: Navy, Gray or White

**Shoes:** Dress shoes or tennis shoes  
Dress shoes must have an enclosed heel and toe.  
Shoe string colors must match shoes

**Accessories:** Belts (*solid colors only*)  
Socks – Color: Black, Brown, or white

### Additional:

- Absolutely no baggies, cargo pants, jeans, sweatsuit pants, pajamas, logos, insignias, pictures, or messages on clothing
- No oversized clothing will be allowed. Pants must fit and be worn around the waist.
- No coats, jackets, hooded sweatshirts, caps, or hats are to be worn during the school day. These items must be left in the student's locker.
- No slip-on footwear, mules, slip-on tennis shoes, slippers, or moccasins

**Enforcement:** The school will strive to achieve full compliance through the use of positive reinforcement measures, and will resort to disciplinary action only when positive measures and supports fail to assure compliance.

**Pants:** Students may wear slacks, shorts, or skirts

'Dockers' Type  
Skirts must be proper length – no more than 2" above the knee  
*If leggings are worn with skirts, the legging must be the same color as the skirts*
- Color: Tan (Khaki) or Black  
Pants must have belt loops

**Sweaters or Sweatshirts:** May be worn over school button-down shirts or polo shirts only

- Sweaters or sweatshirts  
may only be plain or have school logo  
sweatshirts may not have hoods
- Color: Burnt Orange, Gray or White

**Shoes:** Dress shoes or tennis shoes  
Dress shoes must have an enclosed heel and toe.  
Shoe string colors must match shoes

**Accessories:** Belts (*solid colors only*)  
Socks – Color: Black, Brown, or White

### Additional:

- Absolutely no baggies, cargo pants, jeans, sweatsuit pants, pajamas, logos, insignias, pictures, or messages on clothing
- No oversized clothing will be allowed. Pants must fit and be worn around the waist.
- No coats, jackets, hooded sweatshirts, caps, or hats are to be worn during the school day. These items must be left in the student's locker.

# Middle School Dress Code

## Ervin Middle School

- Shirts must be white, orange or black with a collar or turtleneck. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. The color of the undergarment must match the color of the outer shirt. Gray is not an approved color.
- Pants and skirts must be tan (khaki) or black (no denim or cargo). Pants must be worn at the waist and with a belt (no sagging). Skirts must be fingertip length or longer.
- Shorts (during season) must be tan (khaki) or black (no denim). Shorts must be at least fingertip length.
- Belts must be brown or black and worn at all times.
- Shoes must be brown, black or white (no color shoelaces). Tennis shoes may be worn, but not with colored shoe laces. No flip-flops shall be worn.
- Sweaters and or sweatshirts must be white, black, orange or gray. Sweatshirts must be crewneck (no hooded sweaters or sweatshirts).
- No hats, caps or sunglasses may be worn in the building.
- Jewelry: Students may wear earrings and/or watches. No other jewelry is permitted.

## Smith-Hale Middle School

- Shirts must be navy, gray, or white with a collar or turtleneck. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. The color of the undergarment must match the color of the outer shirt.
- Pants and skirts must be tan (khaki) or navy (no denim or cargo). Pants must be worn at the waist with a belt (no sagging). Skirts must be fingertip length or longer.
- Shorts (during season) must be tan (khaki) or navy. Shorts must be at least fingertip length.
- Belts must be brown or black and worn at all times.
- Shoes must be brown, black, navy or white (no colored shoelaces). Tennis shoes may be worn, but not colored shoe laces. No flip-flops shall be worn.
- Sweaters and or sweatshirts may be worn in keeping with school colors (white, navy or gray). Sweatshirts must be crewneck (no hooded sweaters or sweatshirts).
- No hats, caps or sunglasses may be worn in the building.
- Jewelry: Students may wear earrings, watches, necklaces and/or bracelets. No oversized, colored and/or plastic accessories such as bangle bracelets, necklaces and/or earrings.

## Elementary

- Solid navy or khaki pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, jumpers, Capri pants or pants/slacks of appropriate size (no knit pants, leggings, jogging or cargo pants, no zippers or pockets on pant legs).
- Uniforms must be worn and belted at the natural waist (no sagging) and made of standard uniform material (cotton and/or twill), no denim.
- Shorts, skirts, skorts and jumpers must be no shorter than three inches above the knee.
- Solid white or solid navy collared shirts may have the school insignia if one is available, but no other ornamentation is permitted. All shirts must be tucked inside clothing.
- All shoes must be enclosed and fastened/tied properly. No flip-flops shall be worn.
- Solid white or solid navy socks or tights.
- Solid white or navy sweaters or sweatshirts may be worn over uniform shirts. No hooded sweatshirts.
- No hats, caps or sunglasses may be worn in the building.
- Extreme hair color and/or styles that cause disruptions or interfere with the learning environment will not be allowed.

Many area stores stock uniforms and articles of clothing that meet uniform requirements. Any questions regarding the uniform policy can be addressed at each individual school.
