DOBBS STUDENT GIVES HER ALL FOR HAITIAN RELIEF EFFORT

Since Dobbs Elementary School, 9400 Eastern, started their *Operation: Haiti* fundraiser, they have raised more than \$1,800. But one particular donation caught the eye and heart of English to Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) teacher Ryan Rumpf—a donation made by a Dobbs fourth-grade student.

“She came in and wanted to give her entire piggy bank along with a backpack filled with sanitary goods like soap and toilet paper to the people of Haiti,” Rumpf said. “There was \$30.47 in her piggy bank.

“This was one of the noblest acts I’ve ever seen from a student!”

Dobbs is sending the \$1,800 to the School of Hope, a K-12 school of about 1,300 students 30 miles north of Port-au-Prince, Haiti’s capitol and one of the area’s hardest hit by the January 12 earthquake. In the last two weeks, schools in the Hickman Mills C-1 School District have raised several thousand dollars for Haitian relief.
