

## **Federal Notice of Teacher and Paraprofessional Qualifications**

The No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (Public Law 107-110) requires the Hickman Mills C-1 School District to inform parents and/or guardians of certain information.

Upon your request, our district is required to provide to you in a timely manner, the following information:

- Whether the Title 1 teacher has met state qualifications and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction.
- Whether the Title 1 teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which state qualification or licensing criteria have been waived.
- Whether a child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.
- What baccalaureate degree major the teacher has and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher, including the field of discipline of the certification.

In addition to the information that parents or guardians may request, our district must provide each individual parent or guardian:

- Information on the achievement level of the parent/guardian's child in each of the state academic assessments; and
- Timely notice that the parent/guardian's child has been assigned, or has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a Title 1 teacher who is not highly qualified.
